Quota allocation and quota authorisation

Allocation of quota: Quotas are needed for the import and production of bulk HFCs.

Quotas are allocated based on a company-specific reference value (determined every 3 years; see below) and/or based on an annual declaration of (additional) anticipated needs from a quota reserve. Companies wishing to apply for import and production of bulk HFCs from this reserve have to make a declaration for the subsequent year in the HFC Registry (via the <u>F-gas Portal</u>). The <u>latest dates of the</u> <u>declaration period</u> – usually in the period April to May – are published in the Official Journal early each year. A <u>**quick guide**</u> (••••) illustrating the steps for submitting a quota declaration is available.

PROTECTION OF THE OZONE LAYER AND REDUCING F-GASES

The European Union has a strong commitment to protect the ozone layer and has put in place egislation that is among the strictest and most advanced in the world. The EU has not only implemented what has been agreed under the Montreal Protocol on protecting the ozone layer but has often phased out dangerous substances faster than required. The EU is also concerned about the implications for the climate of highly warming alternatives to ozone depleting substances and has adopted stringent controls to reduce such fluorinated greenhouse gases (F-gases).
